

Christmas Catalogue Lucky Number Competition

Terms and Conditions

1. The Promoter is John Danks and Son Pty Ltd, ABN 64 004 037 049, 414 Lower Dandenong Road, Braeside, Victoria 3195.
2. Information regarding prizes and how to enter forms part of the conditions of entry. By entering the Christmas Catalogue Lucky Number Competition ("Promotion") entrants accept these terms and conditions.
3. Entry is open to Australian residents aged 18 years or older who receive the Promoter's special edition Christmas 2009 catalogue ("Catalogue"). Employees and their immediate families of the Promoter and its printers, suppliers, and agencies associated with this Promotion are ineligible.
4. The Promotion starts on Wednesday 25th November 2009 at 00:01am AEST and ends on Thursday 24th December 2009 at 23:59pm AEST ("Promotional Period").
5. There are 50 prizes to be won. Each prize is a \$50 Thrifty-Link Hardware gift card, with a retail value of \$50.00 (inc GST). The total prize pool \$2,500 including GST.
6. To enter this Promotion, entrants must log on to www.thriftylink.com.au and follow the entry instructions. Entrants will be asked to correctly enter their unique Catalogue code ("Code") and name, email address, address details, phone and mobile numbers, gender, date of birth, state, and nearest store.
7. Only one entry per household is permitted. Entrants can only enter in their own name. The same Code cannot be used more than once. Unrecognised codes will not be accepted.
